

# City of Adelaide - in a Bottle

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1. Peel the label from a **Dickford's** juice bottle; use mineral turpentine or solvent to dissolve the glue. Clean bottle with warm water and detergent.

2. Cut out blue 'ocean' rectangle with ship. Cut out white sections at bow and stern, but DON'T cut through point of black bowsprit.

Cut around bowsprit, around yellow tabs & along dark solid lines at bow and stern. Bend yellow tabs down.

3. Use sharp point & ruler to score along black dotted lines above & below each side + green dotted lines around edge of blue 'ocean'.

4. Fold along dotted lines of ship so that sides are upright. Stick C1 & C2 over blue ocean at other side - up to red line.

5. Wrap 1 grey flap at stern over yellow tab & glue. Repeat with stern flap on other side to form rounded stern.

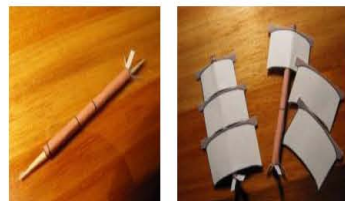
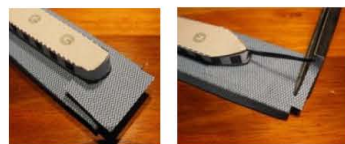
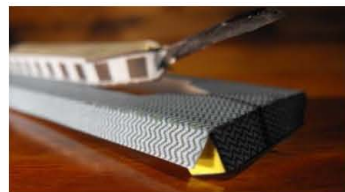
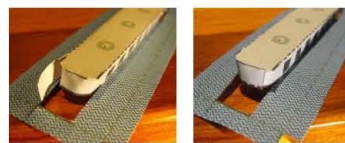
6. Fold bowsprit point and squeeze both sides together. When they match, glue them together. Glue both sides of bow onto yellow tabs. Glue and pinch sides of bow together.

7. Fold down the four sides of the blue 'ocean' rectangle along green dotted lines and stick each to the yellow tabs.

8. Glue W1 and W2 over the gaps at stern and bow. Trim overhang back to green dotted line.

9. Cut out masts M1, M2 & M3 including 3 tabs at bottom of each. Roll each mast round toothpick & glue to form tube. Fold tabs out. Glue sets of sails S1, S2, S3 onto each mast starting with smallest sail at top mark. Also glue lower sails to bottom corners sail above.

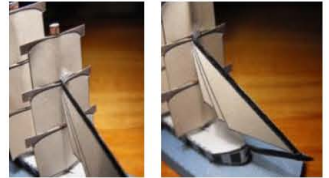
10. Glue each mast onto its correct position on deck using tabs at mast bottom so sails are angled across ship.



11. Glue sail S5 to mast 3 behind bottom sail



12. Fold and glue end (1) of sail S4's black "rope" between top and middle sails of mast M1. When that glue is dry, glue end (2) of the rope behind bowsprit point. Cut off any extra rope below bowsprit.



13. Cut around groove in bottle closest to neck (or base if you prefer). Leave a small 1/2 cm 'hinge'



14. Gently push ship into bottle, bowsprit towards the mouth.



15. Close bottle and use small pieces of adhesive tape to hold cut closed. Glue B1 over B2 to lengthen the braid R1. Glue R1 round bottle to hide cut and cover tape pieces.



16. Score the dotted lines on stand1 and stand 2. Glue tabs marked L behind tabs marked X of same number.



17. Glue the ends of the panels with ship names between L1 & L3, L2 & L4 to make the stand.



18. Rest bottle on top of stand.
